Your Committee on Intrastate Commerce, to which was referred
S.B. No. 2931, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO DENTISTRY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to amend the ethics continuing
education requirement for dentists to require six hours of ethics
training within each biennial renewal period instead of three
hours annually.

The Board of Dental Examiners, Oahu County Committee on
Legislative Priorities of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i, Hawaii
Dental Association, and many individuals testified in support of
this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by making technical,
nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity,
consistency, and style.

your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B.
