Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred  
S.C.R. No. 185, S.D. 1, entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING STATEWIDE SUPPORT FOR  
TRAFFIC SAFETY LEGISLATION TO REDUCE MOTOR VEHICLE FATALITIES  
AND INJURIES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to urge statewide support of  
traffic safety legislation to reduce motor vehicle fatalities and  
injuries.

The Department of Transportation and Oahu County Committee on  
Legislative Priorities of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i testified  
in support of this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Deleting reference to establishing a universal helmet  
law that requires all motorcycle, moped, and bicycle  
riders to wear a helmet while riding on public roadways  
to reduce a rider's chance of traumatic brain injury or  
paralysis after an accident;



- (2) Deleting reference to prohibiting persons from riding in the cargo area of a pickup truck to reduce preventable fatalities and injuries; and
- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of style, clarity, and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Transportation that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 185, S.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it be referred to your Committee on Finance in the form attached hereto as S.C.R. No. 185, S.D. 1, H.D. 1.
