HB 2176, HD2 (HSCR1112-18) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Establishes a process for awarding Department of Education contracts for student transportation services and facility construction that includes public comment. Prohibits protests and judicial review of contract awards made pursuant to the process. (HB2176 HD2)	EDU, WAM
HB 2163, HD1 (HSCR848-18) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO EARLY EDUCATION. Appropriates funds to the Executive Office on Early Learning for additional operational costs, including equipment, supplies, and personnel costs. (HB2163 HD1)	EDU, WAM
