HB 2318, HD1 (HSCR894-18) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO CONFIDENTIAL PERSONAL INFORMATION. Amends the definition of "confidential personal information" for offenses against property rights. Specifies other types of confidential personal information. Clarifies when a password constitutes confidential personal information. (HB2318 HD1)	JDC
HB 860, HD1 (HSCR1068) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO ACTIONS FOR QUIET TITLE. Provides that where a quiet title action involves kuleana land, at the request of a defendant or defendants, the court shall order mandatory mediation or consolidation of separate actions, respectively; defendant's access to the land for native Hawaiian cultural and traditional practices shall not be extinguished or alienated; and plaintiff shall not recover cost, expenses, or attorney's fees. (HB860 HD1)	JDC
