Requires the design of all state buildings constructed on or after July 1,

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Submit testimony in ONE of the following ways:


PAPER: 12 copies (including an original) to Room 311 in the State Capitol;

WEB: For testimony less than 20MB in size, transmit from <http://www.capitol.hawaii.gov/submittestimony.aspx>.


Testimony submitted will be placed on the legislative website. This public posting of testimony on the website should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
