Establishes the Grid Resiliency Rebate Program and a Grid Resiliency Task Force to prepare the State's electrical grid for natural disasters and other emergencies. <p><u>HB 2460, HD2</u> <u>(HSCR823-18)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u></p>	<p>RELATING TO MICROGRIDS. Authorizes the establishment of a Natural Energy Laboratory of Hawaii Authority (NELHA) microgrid demonstration project for the generation, storage, and distribution of renewable energy on property controlled by NELHA. (HB2460 HD2)</p>	<p>TRE/CPH, WAM</p>
