Allows the registered owner of a motor vehicle to designate a beneficiary to whom ownership of the vehicle shall be transferred upon the registered owner's death; provided that certain conditions are met. <u>HB 2108, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR798-18)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS TO ASSIST A SEAWATER AIR CONDITIONING PROJECT IN HAWAII. Extends the authorization to issue special purpose revenue bonds to assist Kaiuli Energy, LLC, with the financing of the planning, design, and construction of a seawater air conditioning district cooling facility and chilled water distribution system. (HB2108 HD1)	TRE, WAM
<u>HB 2161</u> <u>(HSCR834-18)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO VEHICLE INSPECTION STATIONS. Changes the penalty for improper conduct of motor vehicle inspections at inspection stations from revocation or suspension of the station's operating permit to a fine.	Pending re-referral to TRE, WAM
<u>HB 2274, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1108-18)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING INFRASTRUCTURE. Expands the State's existing electric vehicle charging requirements to include parking lots for multi-unit buildings and workplaces. Creates a ratio to calculate the total number of electric vehicle parking stalls a parking facility with more than 200 stalls must have beginning 7/1/2021. Allows the director of transportation to fine properties not in compliance with the electric vehicle parking requirements. Effective 7/1/2020.	Pending re-referral to TRE, WAM
