| <u>SB 2077, SD1</u><br><u>(SSCR2921)</u><br><u>Status</u> | RELATING TO WILDLIFE.<br>Authorizes the department of land and natural resources to enter into the interstate wildlife violator compact or similar agreement for mutual assistance in the enforcement of wildlife laws. Takes effect on 07/01/2050. (SD1)  | WAL, JUD, FIN |
| <u>SB 481, SD2</u><br><u>(SSCR2784)</u><br><u>Status</u>  | RELATING TO IMPORTANT AGRICULTURAL LANDS.<br>Adds the definition of "landowner" to the provisions relating to the identification and designation of important agricultural lands. (SD2)  | WAL, FIN      |
| <u>SB 3058, SD2</u><br><u>(SSCR2680)</u><br><u>Status</u> | RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS.<br>Establishes procedures for designating public land redevelopment districts, planning committees, district redevelopment plans, and designated redevelopment district revolving funds. Establishes powers and duties of planning committees. Appropriates funds. Establishes the Waiakea peninsula redevelopment district, planning committee, and revolving fund until 6/30/2028. Status

RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT  
AUTHORITY.

WAL, LAB, FIN

Establishes the east Kapolei community development district under the Hawaii Community Development Authority. Repeals the laws relating to the Kakaako community development district and replaces members representing the Kakaako community development district of the Hawaii Community Development Authority with members representing the east Kapolei community development district. Makes conforming amendments. Requires the Hawaii Community Development Authority to establish a plan, by 1/1/2020, to return various responsibilities of the Kakaako district to the City and County of Honolulu. (SD2)

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Submit testimony in ONE of the following ways:


