The Senate Committee on Ways and Means and the House Committee on Finance will conduct a joint informational briefing on Chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, grant applications.

3. Neighbor Island applicants will be heard in reverse alphabetical order first, followed by Oahu applicants
