<a href="#">SB 2712</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR. Includes distilled beverages containing spirits and added blending materials that contain less than twelve per cent of alcohol by volume in the cooler beverage definition. Deletes definition of draft beer. Applies the tax rate on draft beer to all beer.	WAM
<a href="#">SB 2756</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO THE CONVEYANCE TAX. Repeals the statutory cap on the disposition of conveyance taxes dedicated for deposit into the Rental Housing Revolving Fund for the financing of affordable rental housing development.	WAM

Authorizes the issuance of special purpose revenue bonds to assist Wahiawa General Hospital with completion of deferred facilities and maintenance projects that are necessary for the health and safety of patients and staff.
