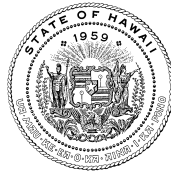

RELATING TO LAND USE

House Bill No. 1985, H.D. 1, Proposed S.D. 1, establishes the Mauna Kea Management Authority to manage the Mauna Kea lands; creates the Mauna Kea Management Revolving Fund to pay for the Authority's expenses; appropriates \$800,000 in general funds for FY 19 for start-up costs for the Authority; and appropriates \$250,000 in Mauna Kea Management Revolving Funds for FY 19 for administration, capital improvement projects and other purposes.

While the Department of Budget and Finance takes no position on the establishment of the Mauna Kea Management Authority, as a matter of general policy, the department does not support the creation of any revolving fund which does not meet the requirements of Section 37-52.4, HRS. Revolving funds should:

- 1) serve a need as demonstrated by the purpose, scope of work and an explanation why the program cannot be implemented successfully under the general fund appropriation process;
- 2) reflect a clear nexus between the benefits sought and charges made upon the users or beneficiaries or a clear link between the program and the sources of revenue;
- 3) provide an appropriate means of financing for the program or activity; and
- 4) demonstrate the capacity to be financially self-sustaining.

With regards to House Bill No. 1985, H.D. 1, Proposed S.D. 1, it is difficult to determine whether the revolving fund will be financially self-sustaining.

HB 1985 as originally passed by the House was a modest and reasonable bill, requiring that the BLNR "provide an annual report to the Legislature with information regarding the value, current zoning, and status of resource value public lands" that it holds.

The proposed SD 1 modification to HB 1985, however, guts this modest language and essentially is a means to "sneak" the nearly universally opposed SB 3090 through the back door.

While Senator Kahele claims that this bill has significant changes compared to SB 3090, it relies on the same faulty premises and will result in the same catastrophic consequences.

Despite literally **hundreds of testimonies in opposition to this plan** from both sides in the debate of over Maunakea with almost zero support, the legislature still seems intent in pushing it forward for reasons that are unclear to anyone.

If astronomers, PUEO members and other pro-TMT Hawaiians, cultural practitioners, Hawaiian sovereignty activists, TMT protesters, and everyone in between see this bill as disastrous, perhaps the legislature should admit that this bill is in fact a mistake and let it die a quick death.

I STRONGLY oppose this bill. While I appreciate the intent of this bill to protect the cultural and natural resources of Maunakea, its specific motivation to create an entirely new management authority is misplaced and the bill, if implemented, would bring about disastrous consequences.

First, I simply and strongly disagree that OMKM should be replaced another, entirely new agency. While the bill rightly notes that the 1998 state audit of Maunakea's management was highly critical, the Office of Mauna Kea Management was formed and the 2000 Master Plan was formulated in direct response to management criticisms, constituting "a new organizational structure, management system, and procedures." The 2014 audit was not nearly as negative as this bill's language seems

to imply, instead noting that “UH and BLNR have made progress in implementing many of [the office’s] recommendations”, finding that “UH and DLNR’s updated plans, leases, and observatory permits provide an improved framework for protecting Mauna Kea lands.”

Any fair-minded assessment would also conclude that OMKM is diligently implementing recommendations made by the 2014 auditor’s report, as described last summer in “Follow-Up Audit of the Management of Mauna Kea and the Mauna Kea Science Reserve”). The report concludes that as of last year 4 of the 7 currently-applicable recommendations have been implemented at least in large part. Many of the non-implemented recommendations are held up by other agencies/offices, not OMKM. For instance, the completion of Recommendation 2 hinges on feedback received during the administrative rules process which must be initiated by the governor’s office. Even then, there is new progress. For example, the University has now completed draft administrative rules (previously stalled by the governor’s office) which have been approved and reviewed by Kahu Ku Mauna and MKMB.

As described by numerous testimonies at the recent BLNR meeting (Jan. 26), the difference in management of Maunakea pre-OMKM and under OMKM is night and day: the mountain is highly regulated, the ranger program does well with ensuring safe access, and the observatories are clean and free of trash/debris surrounding them. The community at large acknowledges OMKM’s stewardship of Maunakea in tangible ways. The Kona-Kohala Chamber of Commerce has now twice honored OMKM with its PÅ«alu Award, in 2016 for its innovative, community-focused activities focused on environmental protection and last year for the agency’s Long-Term Historic Property Monitoring Plan. The Historic Hawaii Foundation likewise lauded OMKM its protection of cultural resources through this plan.

These positive assessments are in line with my own experience, as an astronomer by vocation and a frequent visitor to the summit of Maunakea since 2006. The past 11 ½ years have provided me ample opportunities to witness OMKM’s ability to care for and manage Maunakea. I firmly believe that OMKM excels at the exceptionally difficult task of managing and protecting the natural and cultural resources of Maunakea, while providing an unrivaled center for scientific discovery through astronomical research and safe access to the summit for a wide range of visitors. I have found OMKM personnel to be highly professional and knowledgeable about the many facets of Maunakea that Hawai’i residents value.

Second, the bill if implemented would, at best, create unnecessary and significant chaos, severely impeding the stewardship of a mountain so many Hawai’ians hold dear. This bill would take effect upon its approval. In doing so, the bill would remove numerous experienced, seasoned managers and effective infrastructure of management essentially overnight. In its place, it would put an entirely new

infrastructure, new people, filled with stakeholders who do not necessarily have any experience at all in managing a conservation district, and expect them (on day one) to manage this very complex and challenging place. This is a recipe for disaster.

Coupled with the ostensibly extremely short timeline for implementation is extremely loose language about the status/possible renegotiation of current subleases and future development on the mountain that could either be weaponized against the astronomy community or alternatively allow the university to skirt rules. For instance, the cap of 13 telescopes on the mountain is vague. Would the entirety of CSO need to be removed for TMT to even put up fencing on its site for construction? Alternatively, would removing the mirror for Hoku'kea count as "removing a telescope"? This imprecision only invites more legal challenges. Another example. Almost the entire community (the majority in favor of TMT and minority opposed) believes there should be limits on new development, with Governor Ige suggesting that TMT should be the last new site developed. While the bill caps the number of telescopes, there is no language in the bill that would, say, prevent development (after TMT) on currently undisturbed sites, only that the total footprint is capped (and how would this be determined? SMA's 'footprint' by some definitions is adjustable).

The bill suggests that the current subleases "shall be transferred to the authority and shall be subject to renegotiation upon mutual agreement of the parties." This is insane. The current subleases, which are legally binding contracts, run through 2033. How exactly will this 'mutual agreement' be reached? All this will accomplish is entangling the authority in an endless string of lawsuits, which will only enrich the pocketbooks of lawyers and otherwise satisfy no one. While the legislature should be commended for their interest in the management of Maunakea, I strongly feel that this bill, taken in its entirety, just makes things much worse.

Certainly, there are aspects of Maunakea's management that could be improved. For example, through the adoption of the administrative rules or other means, the rangers should be given greater enforcement powers. I personally would also like to see substantial revisions to the way in which the Visitor's Center is run. Other specific items in the bill are good ideas: e.g. requiring that, as a condition of their sublease renewals, the telescopes follow TMT's lead and describe in a formal way how they will give back to the community through more local jobs and greater educational opportunities. The community would benefit from improving the existing, working system through these focused additions considered in a future legislative session rather than this bill.

If the legislature seems absolutely intent on passing a bill on something related to the

management of Maunakea, the absolute worst thing to do is to pass a bill that has bipartisan opposition such as this one. A much better option would be to focus on targeted issues (in a special legislative session or next year) that have broad, bipartisan support, including enforcement powers for rangers, conditions for the renewal of subleases, and giving OMKM administrative rules. If there are to be any substantial and fundamental changes to management of Maunakea in the future, they should express the consensus of the community at large.

Maunakea is revered by so many in Hawai'i. It is special to me as well, both professionally and personally. It must be protected and its cultural and natural resources preserved. This bill does not protect Maunakea but will damage it. I am thankful for the dedication and expertise of OMKM personnel who excel at protecting this special place.

Testimony in Opposition to Establishing and Appropriating Funds for a Mauna Kea Management Authority

Bill Identifier SB3090 SD2

Aloha e Hawaii State Legislature:

I oppose the establishment of a Mauna Kea Management Authority introduced by Dela Cruz, English, Espero, Galuteria, Harimoto, Inouye, K. Kahele, Keith-Agaran, Kidani, Kim, Nishihara, Shimabukuro, Wakai, S. Chang, K. Rhoads, Riviere, and Taniguchi. Senate Bill 3090 SD 2 establishes the Mauna Kea Management Authority. It limited the number of telescopes that may be authorized on Mauna Kea. It authorizes the renegotiation of leases, subleases, easements, permits, and licenses pertaining to Mauna Kea. It requires that revenue derived from activities on Mauna Kea be shared with the Office of Hawaiian Affairs. It excludes Mauna Kea lands from the definition of “public lands”. It provides for free access to Mauna Kea for traditional cultural purposes. It establishes police powers and provides for enforcement of laws on land under the jurisdiction of the Mauna Kea Management Authority. It appropriates funds.

I write as a Kanaka Maoli and a student at the University of Hawaii of Manoa, and while my voice may not come from a position of power, I have closely followed the events that have unfolded around Mauna Kea over the past decade considering both science and culture, politics and justice, and it is precisely those voices which may not be attached to any position or title which should be heard more consistently, given more considerate thought, because they are the large majority of the voices on this island.

I oppose the Mauna Kea Management Authority measure for several reasons and will discuss a few key reasons below.

1. The progress of this bill through the legislature continues to silence the voices of Kanaka Maoli. Despite 700 testimonies in opposition to Senate Bill 3090 (SD1 Proposed) and only four in support of the creation of a Mauna Kea Management Authority, the Senate Higher Education and Water and Land Committee passed SB 3090 SD1 Proposed with amendments. Despite open and vocal participation, the bill has not undergone a thorough vetting process by the very people upon whom it would have the most significant cultural impact. As a result of the lack of vetting, the bill does not accurately represent the interests or wants of the Kanaka Maoli and continues to only uphold the appearance of providing support to Kanaka Maoli. The Aha Moku Advisory Committee have noted that kupuna find the bill lengthy, and difficult to digest, and the same can be said of college students, of which the bill had to be reviewed several times over to understand the myriad of implications contained therein. Adequate time should be given so all community members whom are able to review, process, and form opinion are able to provide

informed testimony that should be taken into account in new drafts. Continuing to move this bill through the process has and will only exacerbate the feeling of disrespect on the behalf of the government towards the Kanaka Maoli in their disregard for Indigenous voices of objection and builds upon the history of the overthrow of our independent government in spite of national protest despite going through the “legal” hoops.

2. The bill facilitates the development and management of Mauna Kea instead of conservation and preservation. The Mauna Kea Management Authority as described within the bill operates as a property manager; leasing to other organizations, continue development on Mauna Kea to fund future management; and reserves Authority member seats for business experts without prerequisite regarding their Hawaiian cultural knowledge or genealogical tie to the mauna. Furthermore, the Mauna Kea Management Authority would be attached to the Department of Accounting and General Services, whose mission does not include conservation. The focus upon revenue generated from Mauna Kea through leases and commercial tourism fees through sections 44 and 45 dilute and deride from the true cultural importance of Mauna Kea, which has been the banner under which efforts in opposition to the University of Hawaii’s management of the mauna have rallied for years. Section 38 regarding management of access and the establishment of a visitor kiosk as well as a shuttle service to provide individuals with access to the summit of Mauna Kea emphasizing the running of the mauna as though it were primarily a tourist destination. The emphasis throughout this bill on corporate interest and tourism is unsettling in the context of the fight for Mauna Kea being primarily a cultural one. Providing monetary support to the Office of Hawaiian Affairs via business transactions conducted on the Mauna Kea treating the mountain as another lot of land to be bought and sold and toured is not the end game which many activists Kanaka Maoli have fought for. These powers give the Mauna Kea Management Authority the power to exploit and limit access to Mauna Kea through the establishment of entrance fees and management rules and regulations without guarantee that its arbitrary decisions will be in the best interests of Kanaka Maoli.
3. While this bill limits the number of telescopes allowed on Mauna Kea, it does not stop the building of the Thirty Meter Telescope (TMT) or any industrial developments. The fight in today’s political climate regarding Mauna Kea has primarily revolved around the TMT and by that extended to criticisms of the University of Hawaii’s mismanagement and the Board of Land and Natural Resources criticisms. While legislation limiting construction on the mountain is appreciated, it does not address what has and continues to be the central argument: That TMT should not be built upon Mauna Kea. Moreover, the creation of the Mauna Kea Management Authority undermines pending litigation and sidesteps the efforts of a public resolution by relegating Mauna Kea into the hands of yet another governmental body without public input and consideration.
4. The bill establishes the Mauna Kea Management Authority under the appointment of the Governor, whose appointments in the past have already demonstrated a questionable track record in the decision to choose individuals who will considerably consider public input.

Individuals appointed by the governor and in accordance with statements such as: a director of business, economic development, and tourism; the president of the Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs; the president of the East-West Center; a member of the Native Hawaiian Bar Association; a member of the Royal Order of Kamehameha and resident of the island of Hawaii; a representative of a statewide business organization; a member of a private organization invited by the senate; and a member of a private organization invited by the house of representatives. These broad and vague distinctions do not apply qualifications that specifically address issues of conservation, preservation, and cultural integrity. I call into question the ability of the governor to appoint individuals to the Mauna Kea Management Authority without explicit guidelines guiding his decisions in light of the controversies that have surrounded the Board of Land and Natural Resources, which was similarly appointed by the governor, controversies that have included Samuel Gon who has called criticism for being the Board's cultural advisor and voting yes to the construction of the TMT and the criticism brought forth in the hearings that the BLNR did not conduct a public hearing for public input prior to voting and the appointment of a pro-TMT judge to preside over the case, all despite public objection. In all cases of who the Mauna Kea Management Authority should consist of, the legislature must ask who bears the kuleana to speak on the behalf of the lahui on the topic of Mauna Kea to begin with, keeping in consideration that kuleana is always tied to place and genealogy, that it is always relational, that the mauna is for many of us, an ancestor. There is much more to be taken into consideration of who has the kuleana and who has the ability to represent the lahui on the issue of Mauna Kea that this bill inadequately addresses. Furthermore, a much greater emphasis on the lahui's involvement must be placed upon any governing body before it can be said to genuinely represent the Hawaiian peoples beliefs and feelings in government.

This bill draws concerns because there has been a lack of effort into community education, meaningful input, and consensus on the impacts of this bill on the future of Mauna Kea. Senator Kaiali'i Kahele has only recently begun hosting sessions within the community addressing public concerns, and these sessions are limited by venue, time, and resources to adequately cover all aspects of the bill that must be addressed before it should be allowed to continue to pass through the legislature. It is concerning that the language of this bill may keep changing as it moves through legislature without consist review and input from the public. I would like you to consider this bill in the context of a land that has repeatedly experienced the justices of the American justice system and its governmental bodies because of inability to participation in its legal processes. I would like you to consider this bill in the context of the genealogical ties between Kanaka Maoli and Mauna Kea, why we would be overly wary of continued legislation of the mauna in consideration of the history of the State of Hawaii and the University of Hawaii in its mismanagement of the mauna and over land and natural resources throughout the years. Our ability to aloha aina; to recreate, regrow, and transform relationships has been obstructed repeatedly by issues that this bill will exacerbate including privatization and institutional limitations. This bill has the potential to be supported, however, it must be continuously improved through public forum before it should be allowed to enter the legislature and be potentially passed into law. I hope that you will do more to recognize the importance of Mauna Kea to our culture and history, rather than minimizing us once again.

I am Lamaku Mikahala Roy, Kahu of Ahu'ena Heiau at Kamakahonu Hawaii. I inherit the walk begun by my father, Kahu David Keli'ihelemauna Roy, Jr. who led the restoration of Ahu'ena Heiau in the 1970's. I am a Healer and a Teacher who begins anew the work of Kulana Huli Honua, *Foundation of the Search for Wisdom* within the land archive for Kamakahonu, Hawaii named Halau No'EAU Kahelemauna; *the House of Wisdom of the Mountain-Roaming-Chief*.

Ahu'ena Heiau at Kamakahonu is the Seat of the Living Fire of Akua-mana-mana-loa, Divine Creator Most High God. I open my portion of comments tonight in this EIS process by Oli which is the pule (prayer) to Akua Manamana Loa (Divine Creator) and Divine World here.

I am Lamaku Mikahala Roy, Kahu of Ahu'ena Heiau at Kamakahonu. Kamakahonu is the first Capital of the Kingdom of Hawaii unified by Kamehameha the Great. The Ancestors proclaim Mauna Kea the mountain of Akua (Divine Creator). Theirs is the Call to stop desecration. They thank, support and enforce all who have shown great courage to defend the Land and Spirit here.

I have not given my permission for use of any of my images used in your displays tonight. They must be removed or, to continue their use, OMKM must make corrections that meet my approval, reflecting the truth of the history of Kahu Ku Mauna. It is the group that began named 'Ahahui Ku Mauna.

These photos lead the public to believe I am in favor of the continued development of Mauna Kea. Nothing could be further from the truth. As I look around this room at faces of people I've met and have worked with, I'm moved to say "you ought to be ashamed ~ do you call this the carriage of Truth?"

I met some of you in a journey begun prior to 2000. I was asked to join my father, the late Kahu David K. Roy, Jr., in his position on a committee named 'Ahahui Ku Mauna. That committee was convened with the energy of the American / Hawaii-state political system represented by the late Senator Daniel K. Inouye.

Dan Inouye personally called together persons such as my father who led Kanaka Maoli in the restoration of the first Heiau of the modern era in Hawaii, Ahu'ena Heiau, at Kamakahonu, Kona. Inouye also called on the late Uncle Sonny Kaniho, Pua Kanahale, Larry Kimura and others with a love for Hawaii & Hawaii's true traditions to convene with astronomers who had a love for astronomy. The goal was to help establish a bridge of *mutual* understanding and respect between the Hawaiian people and world Astronomers. The Hawaiian people in those days were stalwart in their strong resistance to further development of Mauna Kea. They desired the disassembly of the existing telescopes and non-renewal of the lease of these ceded lands and so did all members of what became Kahu Ku Mauna.

Astronomers and their state supporters said they were interested in the cosmology of 'Oiwī (people of the bones) of the Pacific. By my walk of experience I can say, they were not and they are not interested. This journey became another stream of acts to achieve the goal of acquiescence in Hawaii's public targeting 'Oiwī and non-'Oiwī who understood the Kingdom of Hawaii was occupied by the U.S. 'Oiwī still own their voices and their land.

In aloha 'aina I stand with the families of this land who trust Akua for the restoration of the Kingdom of Hawaii. As Lamaku of Ahu'ena Heiau, I delivered the following message in the 2014 U.S. Department of Interior ANPRM hearings in Hawaii. Aloha Kakou e ka 'Ohana,

In the mid 1970's Ahu'ena Heiau at Kamakahonu Hawaii was restored by 'Oiwi. David Kahelemauna Roy, Jr. led that effort for Akua and became Kahu of Ahu'ena Heiau by Akua and the people in the 'Aha Kumu Pono at Kamakahonu. Ahu'ena Heiau is the first restored temple of worship in the Hawaiian Islands of the modern era.

Kahuna La'au Lapa'au Morrnah N. Simeona said that the seventies were a time of great spiritual growth for Hawaii and her people. Among numerous efforts carried out meaningfully in the communities, Hokule'a traveled to Kahiki, Ho'oponopono was implemented in the Geneva Convention and taught to the world and Ahu'ena Heiau was restored in the Hawaiian Islands.

This restoration of Ahu'ena Heiau (Burning Altar -- referring to the Great Light there) was guided by Akua in the hearts of the men who came from all islands with the main working crew coming from Kona. There was no Office of Hawaiian Affairs, no presence of a state historic preservation department only dedicated and faithful individuals with pride for the heritage of 'Oiwi, pride in their bloodlines and respect for the First Capital of the Kingdom of Hawaii and all that came with it.

In 2005, I succeeded my father as Kahu of Ahu'ena Heiau. By loving communication with the Ancestors beginning for me in these past years, I'm instructed by them of the name our people have held for the station I inherit by Akua and my father.

I am guided by Akua and by Ancestors who serve Akua Manamanaloa in the Pacific. I learn and teach the cosmology of the first faith of Hawaii, 'aina kulaiwi; ke 'aina mauiauhonua.

Aloha mai kakou,

I am Lamaku Mikahala Roy from Kona and I appreciate all the mana'o being brought forward today. I'm grateful for all gatherings to form and relate as Mauna Kea 'Ohana.

The Ancestors of 'Oiwī are active and worldwide, people actively engage with Divine Realm. In 2010, the commemoration of the 200th anniversary of the unification of the Hawaiian Islands by Kamehameha the Great, Divine Conveyances from the Ancestors of 'Oiwī began at Kamakahonu.

On Mother's Day, 5-10-2015, a woman received a telepathic message from an 'io, she reported, in Waikoloa. She saw in her mind's eye, the bird's features, colors and markings and was told where to look to find him. Driving along the highway, she soon did come upon the One who called her. He had passed on.

This woman made a call that came to me. I went to prayer in the noon hour of that day. A powerful Divine Conveyance came forward. Please see attached. Here is what I'd like to share with you all today. Between the first & second meetings of the Mauna Kea 'Ohana, this event and a most significant ceremony related to it took place.

Akua proclaims a leader by genealogy and divinity, Alii Nui Mo'i Edmund K. Silva, Jr. and the support system formed with the people, Nou Ke Akua Ke Aupuni O Hawaii (For You, Akua, the Government of Hawaii).

Safety comes by Life with Akua. In the desire for Safety and Protection of the Hawaiian Islands from further desecration of Lands and Spirit of 'Oiwī, I hope that the 31 persons arrested and all who support Mauna a Wakea will agree that Guidance from the Source for Hawaii has been received.

Let the Heavenly Lands be protected along with the people by Akua. Let transparent relating characterize the true and worthwhile efforts of aloha 'aina and aloha ka po'e.

E Ho'ola i ke Aupuni Pono'i ~ Revive the government rooted in the righteousness of Akua for the lands and the people.

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Aloha Honorable Senators,

I implore you to oppose HB1985, SD1. I am disturbed this legislative intent has persisted among some despite the overwhelming public opposition. It is my hope that this is the last we see of this, and the Senators of these committees will respect the will of the public on these matters. There is no better reason to represent the constituents of Hawaii than for justice and integrity on behalf of the greater good using democratic principles.

I am going to cite these common objections provided by protectors of Mauna Kea whom I trust and defer to on the appropriate management and cultural protocol on the Mauna. And I will refer you to the testimony of SB3090, a similar measure equally inappropriate and unwelcome by most.

Despite 900 testimonies in opposition to (the now dead) Senate Bill 3090 and only 8 testimonies in support, the language of SB 3090 was resurrected in HB 1985 SD1 Proposed.

This Bill gives the MKMA the power to give 65 year leases, transfer title, and grant licenses and easements WITHOUT public auction.

With an effect date as early as July 1, 2018 and no provisions preventing new telescope development, this bill can be used as a vehicle to "legally" permit the Thirty Meter Telescope by the end of this year which could create a "Standing Rock" like situation here in Hawai'i.

The creation of the MKMA undermines pending litigation in the Hawai'i State Supreme Court regarding the future of sacred Mauna Kea and its fragile environments and sidesteps powerful efforts of Kanaka Maoli and the public toward healing and resolution.

For those reasons and many more cited in opposition to SB3090, the origin of HB1985, I strongly urge you to kill this legislation indefinitely. What would be most prudent, would be to conduct an audit of the management of Mauna Kea as suggested by the Mauna Kea Hui in the Temple Report. I advise if you have any questions on these matters, that you consult with Kealoha Pisciotto to start.

I do not believe mismanagement of Mauna Kea will be fixed by a different type of mismanagement which is unsupported by the majority of the public involved and a poor representation of public will in the legislature, if it were to pass.
