Aloha Chair Dela Cruz, Vice Chair Keith-Agaran and Committee Members,

The Hawaiian Humane Society supports the passage of House Bill 2072, HD2, SD1, which would prohibit the use of specific tethering equipment and techniques that are injurious to dogs.

This bill does not prohibit dog tethering. It gives our humane investigators a tool to educate dog owners about proper tethering equipment that is readily available and appropriate techniques that are easy to implement. Making simple changes should allow dog owners to comply with these rules and keep their pets safe.

We do request the removal of the language on page 4, lines 2-7. While the Society agrees that counseling and education have value in combating animal cruelty, the court already has the discretion to impose these sentencing alternatives so this amendment is unnecessary.

On behalf of the Hawaiian Humane Society, I urge you to pass HB 2072, HD2, SD1, which offers specific, well-defined protections for our canine companions.
