In consideration of HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 119/HOUSE RESOLUTION 104

URGING STATE AGENCIES TO EFFECTIVELY MANAGE AND CONTROL THE FERAL CATS AND CHICKENS ON STATE PROPERTIES WITHIN THEIR RESPECTIVE JURISDICTIONS TO AVOID CREATING A NUISANCE, CAUSING DAMAGE, AND OTHER NEGATIVE IMPACTS TO NEIGHBORING PRIVATE **PROPERTIES**

House Concurrent Resolution 119/House Resolution 104 urge state agencies to manage feral cats and chickens on state properties to avoid creating a nuisance. The Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) offers the following comments.

The Department recognizes that feral cats and chickens can create a nuisance to private landowners. The Department notes that approximately one million acres of land are under its jurisdiction. While total control of chickens or feral cats over this entire land area is not currently feasible, the Department does maintain predator control and nuisance animal control programs for resource management purposes, and does advise and assist private landowners on a case-bycase basis to control nuisance animals on state properties that abut private properties where a nuisance has been reported. The Department will continue these programs to the extent that resources permit.
