**STATEMENT OF THE ILWU LOCAL 142 ON S.B. 2589
MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE
AGING AND DISABILITY RESOURCE CENTER**

The ILWU Local 142 **supports** S.B. 2589, which appropriates funds for the Aging and Disability Resource Center.

The Aging and Disability Resource Centers (ADRCs) in each county are “one-stop shops” to assist caregivers and the elderly and disabled themselves to navigate and access needed services and resources. The ADRCs are run by the Area Agencies on Aging and may operate differently on each island, but the intent is to provide information and referral services for elderly and disabled individuals who need assistance to continue to live at home.
