A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the state sheriff
- 2 division provides security and law enforcement response for all
- 3 state judiciary facilities. On the Kona and Kohala sides of the
- 4 island of Hawaii, the sheriff division is responsible for the
- 5 main courthouse in Kona as well as physically separate locations
- 6 for the drug and family court. The sheriff division is also
- 7 responsible for the courthouses in Hilo and Waimea.
- 8 Responsibility for this vast geographical area makes it
- 9 difficult for the sheriff division to effectively and
- 10 efficiently supervise line deputies and provide necessary
- 11 services. Currently, there is only a single lieutenant in the
- 12 division who is responsible for supervising these courts.
- The legislature also finds that the current level of
- 14 staffing in the sheriff division on the island of Hawaii,
- 15 particularly in the Kona unit, is inadequate for the sheriff
- 16 division to properly perform its duties. Further, the

1	legislature concludes that the Kona unit would be more effective				
2	and efficient with proper staffing.				
3	Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to:				
4	(1)	Establish one full-time equivalent permanent			
5		lieutenant position in the Kona unit of the sheriff			
6		division within the department of public safety; and			
7	(2)	Appropriate funds for the initial six-month hiring			
8		period and for one-time costs for the purchase of			
9		position-related uniforms and equipment, with the			
10		intention that funds for the position will be included			
11		and requested within the department's base budget for			
12		subsequent years at a rate equivalent to the base			
13		salary for the position as determined by the			
14		department.			
15	SECT	TION 2. There is appropriated out of the general			
16	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much				
17	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for the				
18	hiring of one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) permanent				
19	lieutenant position in the Kona unit of the sheriff division				
20	within the department of public safety for the initial six-month				
21	hiring pe	eriod and for one-time costs for the purchase of			

- 1 position-related uniforms and equipment; provided that funds for
- 2 the position shall be included and requested within the
- 3 department's base budget for subsequent years at a rate
- 4 equivalent to the base salary for the position as determined by
- 5 the department.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 7 public safety for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Bill No. and Title: Senate Bill No. 3079, S. D. 1, Relating to Law Enforcement.

Purpose: Establishes one (1) full-time equivalent lieutenant position in the Kona unit of the Sheriff Division within the Department of Public Safety. Chairs Johanson and Takayama, Vice Chairs Holt and Gates, and Members of the Committee:

The Department of Public Safety (PSD) **strongly supports** Senate Bill (SB) 3079, Senate Draft (SD) 1, which would establish one full-time equivalent lieutenant position in the Sheriff Division, Kona unit and appropriate funds for the initial six-month hiring period and for one-time costs for purchase of uniforms and equipment.

The Sheriff Division, Hawaii Section is responsible for all courthouses in Hilo, Waimea, and Kona, including the physically separated drug and family courts. One lieutenant, whose office is in Hilo, currently supervises this vast geographical area of control. A second lieutenant for the Kona unit will allow for more effective and efficient supervision of the line deputies and enhance the capacity to provide the necessary services to the Judiciary and the Hawaii Island community.

PSD would note that HB 1900, HD 1, Relating to the State Budget, includes a House Adjustment to add 1.0 permanent Lieutenant position and funds to the Kona Unit

under PSD 503 Sheriff, Sequence no. 1000-001. The total appropriation is \$85,670, which would fund a full year's salary. We are in full support of either the HB 1900, HD 1 adjustment or this current bill.
