RELATING TO THE STRUCTURE OF GOVERNMENT

Senate Bill No. 3100 consolidates the Department of Human Resources

Development (DHRD) and the Department of Budget and Finance (B&F) into one
department and transfers the departments' powers and duties effective July 1, 2020.

The bill appropriates \$100,000 in general funds for FY 19 to effectuate consolidation of
the two departments into a single department.

B&F has serious reservations with this bill. While we understand the importance of promoting efficiency and effectiveness in State Government, it should be pointed out that the core functions of the two departments are separate and distinct. The possible economies of scale resulting from the consolidation would appear to be minimal since each department is staffed to carry out its own duties and responsibilities. Further, there is only limited functional policy overlap so additional coordination due to consolidation would be marginal. As such, we do not believe the bill would provide more than minor cost savings or significantly improve the effectiveness of State Government.
