Friends of the Library Kahuku (Hereafter FOLK)

FOLK has been raising funds to support the needs of the Kahuku Library for many years. During the past several years we have endeavored on two programs that have been successful with the library but still need more to succeed. The battle of the Books (BOB) and the Cool Lab. We are now ready to get the Cool Lab up and running this year. Bob is going well and we are starting to see improved reading skills in the schools in district 47..

Our goals are to get the cool Lab open and keep the BOB running smoothly

Through the cool lab we hope to provide equipment to the community that is not normally provided by a library but we feel has a need in the community

We are aiming to assist the population in District47 which is primarily the same population that is served by the Kahuku library.

The geographic coverage will be limited to District 47

#### **Financial**

Currently we have no employees, No motor vehicles. There are no capital projects planned and we are not applying for any other government grants. During the year we do apply for private grants such as the Hawaii Community Foundation ( zero donations last two years), Turtle Bay grant generally a small cash donation but a in kind use of their facilities for our BOB program.

We would like to receive \$20,000 in each quarters 1-3 and the balance of \$15,000 in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter.

No tax credits applied for or received.

The are no federal, state or county government grants, contracts, or grants in aid. And there have not been any in the past 3 years.

We currently have \$35,421 in unrestricted assets

#### Experience and capability

We have been providing these the types of programs on a smaller scale for the past several years. We have been limited by our funding but would like to see our programs get the boost that they need.

#### **Facilities**

We currently support the existing Kahuku Library and would like to extend our support to the local public libraries the participate in our programs.

Personnel: Organization and staffing

We are a volunteer board, There are no paid staff from our funds we work with the local librarian who is paid by HSPLS. Our goal is to pay for projects tha are not paid for by HSPLS

We are not involved in any litigation, there is no special Licensure or accreditation needed, and our plans at this time is to only work with the public library and local public schools .

We have been around for many years and will continue to prevail on the scale that our collected funds allow.
