# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION STUDENT IMMUNIZATIONS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that colleges and
- 2 universities are increasing the number of courses and programs
- 3 offered online. The University of Hawaii offered 1,428 sections
- 4 of distance learning in the fall 2018 semester and is preparing
- 5 to increase its offering of exclusively online programs.
- 6 Because methods of educational delivery are changing, certain
- 7 requirements that have been traditionally imposed on students,
- 8 such as immunizations, may not always apply in the same manner
- 9 as they do for traditional classroom instruction.
- 10 The legislature further finds that the department of health
- 11 is currently proposing changes to title 11, chapter 157, Hawaii
- 12 Administrative Rules, relating to examination and immunization.
- 13 The proposed changes include an exemption for online and
- 14 distance learning for post-secondary schools to be implemented
- 15 once the proposed rules are effective, the governor approves
- 16 them, and the amended rules have been filed with the lieutenant
- 17 governor.

## H.B. NO. H.D. 1 S.D. 2

- 1 The legislature additionally finds that the University of
- 2 Hawaii is expanding its online and distance-learning programs
- 3 beginning with the fall 2019 semester. However, the proposed
- 4 rules may not be adopted in time for fall 2019 classes.
- 5 Therefore, students who register exclusively for post-secondary
- 6 online and distance-learning programs for fall 2019, or the
- 7 preceding online summer college transition course, may still be
- 8 subject to the current immunization requirements. The
- 9 department of health and University of Hawaii agree that the
- 10 rule regarding immunization should be amended to exempt post-
- 11 secondary students in online or distance-learning programs who
- 12 do not attend classes in person.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to allow post-secondary students
- 14 who attend classes exclusively online or through distance
- 15 learning to be exempt from the requirements of title 11, chapter
- 16 157, Hawaii Administrative Rules, under certain conditions.
- 17 SECTION 2. Students in post-secondary education programs
- 18 who are registered to attend classes exclusively online or
- 19 through distance learning shall be exempt from the requirements
- 20 of title 11, chapter 157, Hawaii Administrative Rules; provided
- 21 that if a student needs to go on campus for any reason related

- 1 to their online or distance learning class, the student shall be
- 2 subject to the immunization requirements of title 11, chapter
- 3 157, Hawaii Administrative Rules, prior to entering the campus.
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
