BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

8	(2) Unsworn falsification to authorities is a misdemeanor.

14	"State investigator" means a person employed, contracted,

18	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that	
19	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were	
20	begun before its effective date.
