A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SPEECH PATHOLOGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 468E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated	
3	and to read as follows:	
4	" <u>§46</u> 8	8E- Provisional license. (a) The board shall
5	grant, upo	on application and payment of proper fees, provisional
6	licensure	to an individual who:
7	· <u>(1)</u>	Possesses at a minimum a master's degree in the area
8		of speech pathology from an educational institution
9		recognized by the board; and
10	(2)	Engages in clinical or academic practice under the
11		supervision of a licensed speech pathologist during
12		the period of time needed to fulfill the necessary
13		requirements for licensure as a speech pathologist
14		pursuant to section 468E-5; provided that the licensed
15		speech pathologist possesses an American Speech-
16		Language-Hearing Association certificate of clinical
17		competence and is in good standing with the board.

- 1 Each provisional license shall include the name and (b)
- 2 title of the licensed speech pathologist described in subsection
- 3 (a) (2). A provisional licensee may only practice speech
- 4 pathology under the supervision of the licensed speech
- 5 pathologist named on the provisional license.
- 6 (c) A provisional license issued pursuant to this section
- 7 shall be valid for one year from the date of issuance and may be
- 8 renewed for an additional one-year period if needed to fulfill
- 9 the requirements for licensure as a speech pathologist pursuant
- **10** to section 468E-5."
- 11 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2022.
