
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 710-1063, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:

3 "(1) A person commits the offense of unsworn falsification
4 to authorities if, with an intent to mislead a public servant in
5 the performance of the public servant's duty, the person:

6 (a) Makes any statement, in written, printed, or
7 electronic form, which the person does not believe to
8 be true, in an application for any pecuniary or other
9 benefit or in a record or report required by law to be
10 submitted to any governmental agency;

11 (b) Knowingly makes a false statement, in oral, written,
12 printed, or electronic form, to a public servant
13 engaged in criminal, civil, or administrative
14 enforcement activity pursuant to the public servant's
15 investigative or inspection authority;

16 ~~(b)~~ (c) Submits or invites reliance on any statement,
17 document, or record, in written, printed, or



1 electronic form, which the person knows to be falsely
 2 made, completed, or altered; or
 3 [~~e~~] (d) Submits or invites reliance on any sample,
 4 specimen, map, boundary-mark, or other object the
 5 person knows to be false."

6 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
 7 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
 8 begun before its effective date.

9 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
