- 3 76, as amended by Act 99, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, section
- 4 1, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 "SECTION 14. This Act shall take effect on August 1, 2016,
- 6 and shall be repealed on July 1, [2019;] 2021; provided that
- 7 sections 91-14, 174C-12, 183C-8, 206E-5.6, 269-15.5, and 602-5,
- 8 Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in the form in which
- 9 they read on the day prior to the effective date of this Act."
- 10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 2019.

Extends for two years the requirement that decisions in contested case hearings of the Commission on Water Resource Management, Land Use Commission, Public Utilities Commission, Hawaii Community Development Authority, and those involving conservation districts be appealed directly to the Supreme Court, with certain exceptions.
