
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 291-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) No operator of any pickup truck may operate the
4 vehicle with any passenger [~~twelve years of age or under~~] in the
5 bed or load-carrying area of the vehicle, unless one of the
6 following applies:

7 (1) An emergency exists that threatens the life of the
8 passenger being transported in the bed or load-
9 carrying area of the vehicle; or

10 (2) The vehicle is being operated in [~~parades, caravans,~~]
11 a parade, caravan, or [exhibitions which are]
12 exhibition that is officially authorized or otherwise
13 permitted by law."

14 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
16 begun before its effective date.

Extends the general prohibition against the operation of a pickup truck with any passenger 12 years of age or under in the bed or load-carrying area of the vehicle to one that prohibits the operation of the truck while any passenger of any age is in the bed or load-carrying area of the vehicle.
