# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SENTENCING.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 706, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:  
4           "§706- Authority to impose probationary geographic  
5 restriction; Waikiki. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary,  
6 a defendant who has been convicted of a misdemeanor, has two  
7 prior misdemeanor convictions, and each conviction was the  
8 result of an act that occurred within Waikiki may be sentenced  
9 to a probationary term of geographic restriction not exceeding  
10  years during which the defendant shall be prohibited from  
11 entering Waikiki during the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.  
12 Violation of an imposed geographic restriction shall result in  
13 imprisonment of thirty days.  
14           For purposes of this section, "Waikiki" means that area of  
15 Oahu bounded by the Ala Wai canal, the ocean, and Kapahulu  
16 avenue."



# H.B. NO. 1304

1           SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
3 begun before its effective date.

4           SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

5           SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

**Report Title:**

Probation; Geographic Restriction; Misdemeanor Conviction;  
Waikiki

**Description:**

Allows a defendant who has been convicted of three misdemeanors in Waikiki to be sentenced to a probationary term of geographic restriction not exceeding            years during which the defendant shall be prohibited from entering Waikiki during the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Imposes imprisonment of thirty days for violation.
