
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate
2 additional funds for capital improvement projects for the fiscal
3 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021, for
4 the state foundation on culture and the arts program of the
5 department of accounting and general services, which is under
6 the purview of the house of representatives standing committee
7 on tourism and international affairs.

8 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as shall
9 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
10 hereby appropriated out of the works of art special fund for
11 fiscal year 2020-2021.

12 1. To be expended by the department of accounting and general
13 services:

14 A. No. 1 Capitol District
15 Building, Oahu.



1 Design and construction to
 2 renovate building walkway and
 3 entrance, relocation of
 4 property entrance, expansion
 5 of vehicular drop-off and
 6 pick-up area, and other
 7 accessibility improvements to
 8 accommodate increased
 9 requirements of the Americans
 10 with Disabilities Act.

11	Design	\$ 300,000
12	Construction	\$2,300,000
13	Total funding	\$2,600,000

14 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
 15 projects set forth in section 2 shall be expended by the
 16 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 4. The appropriation made for the capital
 18 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 19 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
 20 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
 21 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.
