# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNITED STATES SENATOR DANIEL K. INOUE DAY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended  
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to  
3 read as follows:


4           "§8-           United States Senator Daniel K. Inouye Day.  
5 September 7 of each year shall be known and designated as  
6 "United States Senator Daniel K. Inouye Day" in memory of  
7 Senator Inouye's long life of public service to the State. This  
8 day is not and shall not be construed to be a state holiday."

9           SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

10          SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
