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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY OPERATING BUDGET.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1                                   **PART I. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

2           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish  
3 additional amounts to be appropriated or authorized and  
4 additional positions in the operating budget for the fiscal  
5 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, for the department of public  
6 safety.

7           SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS. Unless otherwise clear from the  
8 context, as used in this Act:

9           "Expending agency" means the department of public safety.

10          Abbreviations, where used to denote the expending agency or  
11 a house of representatives standing committee, shall mean the  
12 following:

13          HLT House of representatives standing committee on health

14          PSD Department of public safety

15          "Means of financing" or "MOF" means the source from which  
16 funds are appropriated or authorized to be expended for the  
17 programs and projects specified in this Act. All appropriations



1 are followed by letter symbols. The letter symbols, where used,  
2 shall have the following meanings:

3 A General funds

4 "Position ceiling" means the maximum number of permanent  
5 and temporary full-time equivalent positions authorized for a  
6 particular program during a specified period or periods, as  
7 denoted by an asterisk for permanent full-time equivalent  
8 positions and a pound sign for temporary full-time equivalent  
9 positions.

10 "Program ID" means the unique identifier for the specific  
11 program and consists of the abbreviation for the organization  
12 responsible for carrying out the program followed by the  
13 organization number for the program.

14 **PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS**

15 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. The following sums, or so much  
16 thereof as may be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and  
17 programs designated herein, are hereby appropriated or  
18 authorized, as the case may be, from the means of financing  
19 specified to the expending agencies designated for the fiscal  
20 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The  
21 total expenditures and the number of positions in each fiscal



1 year of the biennium shall not exceed the sums and the position  
2 ceilings indicated for each fiscal year, except as provided  
3 elsewhere in this Act or as provided by general law.

**PART III. MISCELLANEOUS AND EFFECTIVE DATE**

1 SECTION 4. If any portion of this Act or its application  
2 to any person, entity, or circumstance is held to be invalid for  
3 any reason, then the legislature declares that the remainder of  
4 the Act and each and every other provision thereof shall not be  
5 affected thereby. If any portion of a specific appropriation is  
6 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall  
7 be expended to fulfill the objective of the appropriation to the  
8 extent possible.

9 SECTION 5. If manifest clerical, typographical, or other  
10 mechanical errors are found in this Act, the governor may  
11 correct the errors.

12 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
