## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SEVENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall  
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are  
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of  
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2019-2020:

5           1. To be expended by the department of agriculture:

6           A. Kona agricultural park, Hawaii

7           Plans, design, and construction to connect the R-1  
8 county water lines to the park; ground and site  
9 improvements; and equipment and appurtenances.
