## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FORTY-THIRD REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$87,596,750 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2019-2020  
5 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for  
6 the forty-third representative district, as follows:

7     1. To be expended by the department of education:

8           A. Nanakuli high and  
9               intermediate school, Oahu  
10           Plans, design, and  
11           construction of the Nanakuli  
12           performing arts center  
13           auditorium.

9 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
10 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
11 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
12 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are  
13 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

14 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital  
15 improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by  
16 the designated expending agencies for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
