
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOLS BUDGET.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 **PART I. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

2 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish
3 additional amounts to be appropriated or authorized and
4 additional positions in the operating budget for the fiscal
5 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021, for
6 certain state executive branch programs under the purview of the
7 house of representatives standing committee on lower and higher
8 education.

9 SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS. Unless otherwise clear from the
10 context, as used in this Act:

11 "Expending agency" means the department of education.

12 Abbreviations, where used to denote the expending agency or
13 a house of representatives standing committee, shall mean the
14 following:

15 EDN Department of education

16 LHE House of representatives standing committee on lower
17 and higher education



1 "Means of financing" or "MOF" means the source from which
2 funds are appropriated or authorized to be expended for the
3 programs and projects specified in this Act. All appropriations
4 are followed by letter symbols. The letter symbols, where used,
5 shall have the following meanings:

6 A General funds

7 N Federal funds

8 "Position ceiling" means the maximum number of permanent
9 and temporary full-time equivalent positions authorized for a
10 particular program during a specified period or periods, as
11 denoted by an asterisk for permanent full-time equivalent
12 positions and a pound sign for temporary full-time equivalent
13 positions.

14 "Program ID" means the unique identifier for the specific
15 program and consists of the abbreviation for the organization
16 responsible for carrying out the program followed by the
17 organization number for the program.

18 **PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS**

19 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. The following sums, or so much
20 thereof as may be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and
21 programs designated herein, are hereby appropriated or



1 authorized, as the case may be, from the means of financing
2 specified to the expending agencies designated for the fiscal
3 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The
4 total expenditures and the number of positions in each fiscal
5 year of the biennium shall not exceed the sums and the position
6 ceilings indicated for each fiscal year, except as provided
7 elsewhere in this Act or as provided by general law.


1 **PART III. MISCELLANEOUS AND EFFECTIVE DATE**

2 SECTION 4. If any portion of this Act or its application
3 to any person, entity, or circumstance is held to be invalid for
4 any reason, then the legislature declares that the remainder of
5 the Act and each and every other provision thereof shall not be
6 affected thereby. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
7 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
8 be expended to fulfill the objective of the appropriation to the
9 extent possible.

10 SECTION 5. If manifest clerical, typographical, or other
11 mechanical errors are found in this Act, the governor may
12 correct the errors.

13 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
