A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BUDGET OF THE OFFICE OF HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I. GENERAL PROVISIONS
2	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Act shall be known and may
3	be cited as the Office of Hawaiian Affairs Appropriations Act of
4	2019.
5	SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS. As used in this Act, unless the
6	context otherwise requires:
7	"Means of financing" or "MOF" means the source from which
8	funds are appropriated or authorized to be expended for the
9	programs and projects specified in this Act. All appropriations
10	are followed by letter symbols. These letter symbols, where
11	used, shall mean the following:
12	A general funds
13	T trust funds
14	"Position ceiling" means the maximum number of permanent
15	and temporary full-time equivalent positions authorized for a
16	particular program during a specified period or periods, as
17	denoted by an asterisk (*) for permanent full-time equivalent

- 1 positions and a pound sign (#) for temporary full-time
- 2 equivalent positions.
- 3 "Program ID" means the unique identifier for the specific
- 4 program and consists of OHA, the abbreviation for the office of
- 5 Hawaiian affairs, followed by the organization number for the
- 6 program.
- 7 PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS
- 8 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. The following sums, or so much
- 9 thereof as may be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and
- 10 programs designated herein, are appropriated or authorized from
- 11 the means of financing specified to the office of Hawaiian
- 12 affairs for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and
- 13 ending June 30, 2021. The total expenditures and the number of
- 14 positions in each fiscal year of the biennium shall not exceed
- 15 the sums and the numbers indicated for each fiscal year, except
- 16 as provided elsewhere in this Act, or as provided by general
- 17 law.

1	PART III. PROGRAM PROVISIONS
2	SECTION 4. Provided that the general fund appropriations
3	in part II of this Act shall be expended by the office of
4	Hawaiian affairs.
5	SECTION 5. Provided that of the trust funds appropriated
6	in part II of this Act, the sum of \$ for fiscal year
7	2019-2020 shall be expended for the costs for the auditor to
8	conduct a financial and management audit of the office of
9	Hawaiian affairs. The auditor shall submit a report of the
10	findings and recommendations to the legislature, governor, and
11	the trustees of the office of Hawaiian affairs no later than
12	twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of
13	2020.
14	SECTION 6. Provided that of the funds appropriated for
15	beneficiary advocacy (OHA175), the sum of \$ in general
16	funds and \$ in trust funds for fiscal year 2019-2020 and
17	the same sums for fiscal year 2020-2021 shall be expended to
18	provide for social services, including referral services and
19	case management, to at-risk office of Hawaiian affairs
20	beneficiaries to immediately address unexpected crises; provided
21	further that program activities shall be designed with an

- 1 overall objective to provide financial assistance to improve
- 2 stability during emergency situations; and provided further that
- 3 notwithstanding section 10-17(e), Hawaii Revised Statutes, any
- 4 funds expended for the purposes of this section shall be in
- 5 accordance with chapter 103D or 103F, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 6 or a competitive grants process, as appropriate.
- 7 SECTION 7. Provided that of the funds appropriated for
- 8 beneficiary advocacy (OHA175), the sum of \$ in general
- 9 funds and \$ in trust funds for fiscal year 2019-2020 and
- 10 the same sums for fiscal year 2020-2021 shall be expended to
- 11 provide for educational improvement programs for native Hawaiian
- 12 students; provided further that program activities shall be
- 13 designed to help native Hawaiian students succeed academically;
- 14 and provided further that notwithstanding section 10-17(e),
- 15 Hawaii Revised Statutes, any expenditures for the purposes of
- 16 this section shall be in accordance with chapter 103D or 103F,
- 17 Hawaii Revised Statutes, or a competitive grants process, as
- 18 appropriate.
- 19 SECTION 8. Provided that of the funds appropriated for
- 20 beneficiary advocacy (OHA175), the sum of \$\\$ in general
- 21 funds and \$ in trust funds for fiscal year 2019-2020 and

- 1 the same sums for fiscal year 2020-2021 shall be expended to
- 2 provide for legal services and legal representation to office of
- 3 Hawaiian affairs beneficiaries for:
- 4 (1) The assertion and defense of quiet title actions;
- 5 (2) Assistance with ahupuaa and kuleana tenant rights,
- 6 including rights of access and rights to water;
- 7 (3) Land title assistance, including review of title and
- genealogy;
- 9 (4) Preservation of traditional and customary practices;
- 10 (5) Protection of culturally significant places; and
- 11 (6) Preservation of native Hawaiian land trust
- 12 entitlements;
- 13 provided further that notwithstanding section 10-17(e), Hawaii
- 14 Revised Statutes, any funds expended for the purposes of this
- 15 section shall be made in accordance with chapter 103D or 103F,
- 16 Hawaii Revised Statutes, as appropriate.
- 17 SECTION 9. Provided that of the funds appropriated for
- 18 beneficiary advocacy (OHA 175), the sum of \$ in general
- 19 funds and \$ in trust funds for fiscal year 2019-2020 and
- 20 the same sums for fiscal year 2020-2021 shall provide for
- 21 housing improvement programs to assist native Hawaiians,

- 1 including those that are homeless, at-risk of homelessness, in
- 2 transitional housing, in unstable or unaffordable rentals, or in
- 3 pursuit of homeownership, to increase their capacity to attain
- 4 housing stability. Programs shall be designed with an overall
- 5 objective to address barriers that hinder native Hawaiians from
- 6 obtaining stable housing; provided that notwithstanding section
- 7 10-17(e), Hawaii Revised Statutes, any funds expended for the
- 8 purposes of this section shall be in accordance with chapter
- 9 103D or 103F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, or a competitive grants
- 10 process, as appropriate.
- 11 PART IV. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS AND EFFECTIVE DATE
- 12 SECTION 10. Provided that whenever necessary, the board of
- 13 trustees of the office of Hawaiian affairs or the board's
- 14 designee may transfer sufficient funds and positions between
- 15 programs for operating purposes; provided further that these
- 16 transfers shall be consistent with legislative intent; and
- 17 provided further that the office of Hawaiian affairs shall
- 18 submit a report to the legislature of all uses of this authority
- 19 for the previous twelve month period from December 1 to November
- 20 30, no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the
- 21 regular sessions of 2020 and 2021.

- 1 SECTION 11. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 2 application thereto to any person or circumstance, is held
- 3 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 4 applications of the Act that can be given effect without the
- 5 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 6 of this Act are severable. If any portion of a specific
- 7 appropriation is held to be invalid for any reason, the
- 8 remaining portion shall be expended to fulfill the objective of
- 9 that appropriation to the extent possible.
- 10 SECTION 12. In the event manifest clerical, typographical,
- 11 or other mechanical errors are found in this Act, the board of
- 12 trustees of the office of Hawaiian affairs is authorized to
- 13 correct these errors. All changes made pursuant to this section
- 14 shall be reported to the legislature at its next session.
- 15 SECTION 13. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
