



1 fiscal quarter, the director of finance shall transmit to each  
2 county all the fines and forfeitures collected during the  
3 previous fiscal quarter for uncontested traffic infractions  
4 committed in that county that are in excess of amounts required  
5 by the State to pay the administrative costs of the traffic  
6 violations bureau. The fines and forfeitures deemed excess  
7 pursuant to this subsection shall be transmitted to the county  
8 in which the citations were issued. This section shall not  
9 apply to:

- 10 (1) Fines and forfeitures for violations that occur on  
11 state off-street parking facilities, parks, airports,  
12 and harbors that are subject to enforcement by the  
13 State; and
- 14 (2) Fines and forfeitures that are required by law to be  
15 paid into a special, revolving, or trust fund.

16 Except as provided by this section, no county shall be  
17 entitled to any portion of the fines and forfeitures described  
18 in this section."
