# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

- 1           SECTION 1. (a) There is established a peer-to-peer  
2 regulatory task force located in the department of commerce and  
3 consumer affairs for administrative purposes to consist of the  
4 following members:
- 5           (1) A representative from the department of  
6           transportation;
- 7           (2) A representative from the department of commerce and  
8           consumer affairs' insurance division;
- 9           (3) A representative from the department of commerce and  
10           consumer affairs' office of consumer protection;
- 11           (4) Two representatives from rental car companies  
12           operating in the State, to be selected by the  
13           department of commerce and consumer affairs;
- 14           (5) Two representatives from insurance companies operating  
15           in the State, to be selected by the department of  
16           commerce and consumer affairs; and



1           (6) Two representatives from peer-to-peer motor vehicle  
2           sharing companies operating in the State, to be  
3           selected by the department of commerce and consumer  
4           affairs.

5           (b) The director of commerce and consumer affairs or the  
6           director's designee shall chair the task force.

7           (c) The purpose of the task force is to develop proposed  
8           legislation for the regulation of peer-to-peer motor vehicle  
9           sharing companies and to identify any potential issues currently  
10          unaddressed by state law. The task force shall submit a report  
11          of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed  
12          legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior  
13          to the convening of the regular session of 2020.

14          (d) The task force shall serve until it has accomplished  
15          the purpose of this Act or twenty days prior to the convening of  
16          the regular session of 2020, whichever occurs first.

17          (e) No member of the task force shall be made subject to  
18          section 84-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, solely because of that  
19          member's participation on the task force. The task force shall  
20          be exempt from chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes.



1 (f) The members of the task force shall serve without  
2 compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses, including  
3 travel expenses, necessary for the performance of their duties.

4 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 for the  
7 peer-to-peer regulatory task force established pursuant to this  
8 Act.

9 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department  
10 of commerce and consumer affairs for the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
