A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SUICIDE PREVENTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the neighbor islands
- 2 have higher rates of youth suicide attempts than Oahu.
- 3 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to support
- 4 youth suicide early intervention, prevention, and education
- 5 initiatives in Kauai and Hawaii counties.
- 6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$25,000 or so much
- 8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the
- 9 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 10 2020-2021 to support youth suicide early intervention,
- 11 prevention, and education initiatives in Kauai county that focus
- 12 upon, but are not limited to, persons between the ages of ten
- 13 and twenty-four.
- 14 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 15 of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$50,000 or so much



- 1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the
- 2 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 3 2020-2021 to support youth suicide early intervention,
- 4 prevention, and education initiatives in Hawaii county that
- 5 focus upon, but are not limited to, persons between the ages of
- 6 ten and twenty-four.
- 7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 8 of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
