# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PERMIT FEES FOR AERIAL DEVICES, DISPLAY FIREWORKS,  
AND ARTICLES PYROTECHNIC.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the display permit  
2 fee, which authorizes licensed pyrotechnicians to conduct  
3 outdoor and close proximity fireworks for public or private  
4 events or for theatrical or movie purposes, has remained the  
5 same for sixteen years. However, the cost to process, review,  
6 and approve display permits has increased.

7           The purpose of this Act is to raise the fireworks display  
8 permit fee from \$110 to \$300 to keep pace with increased  
9 administrative costs.

10           SECTION 2. Section 132D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
11 amended to read as follows:

12           "**§132D-10 Permits.** A permit shall be required for the  
13 purchase and use of:

14           (1) Any consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers  
15           upon payment of a fee of \$25;

- 1           (2) Any aerial devices, display fireworks, or articles  
2           pyrotechnic for the purposes of section 132D-16 upon  
3           payment of a fee of [~~\$110,~~] \$300; and  
4           (3) Any consumer fireworks for the purposes of section  
5           132D-5 or for cultural uses that occur at any time  
6           other than during the periods prescribed in section  
7           132D-3(1) upon a payment of a fee of \$25."

8           SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10          SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2020.
