## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LITTERING.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 339-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3           "(a) Except as otherwise provided by this chapter, any  
4 person violating any provision of this chapter or any rule  
5 adopted under this chapter shall be guilty of a violation, and  
6 shall be fined not less than \$100, and not more than [~~\$500~~  
7 \$1,000 for each offense, and ordered to pick up and remove  
8 litter from a public place under the supervision of the director  
9 as follows:

10           (1) For the first offense, the violator shall spend four  
11 hours of either picking up litter or performing  
12 community service; and

13           (2) For any subsequent offense, the violator shall spend  
14 eight hours of either picking up litter or performing  
15 community service."

16           SECTION 2. Section 708-829, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
17 amended by amending subsection (4) to read as follows:



1        "(4) The court shall sentence any person convicted of  
2 committing the offense of criminal littering as follows:

3        (a) For the first offense, the person shall spend four  
4 hours of either picking up litter on public property  
5 or performing community service;

6        (b) For any subsequent offense, the person shall spend  
7 eight hours of either picking up litter on public  
8 property or performing community service; and

9        (c) The court shall fine the person convicted of  
10 committing the offense of criminal littering at least  
11 \$500, but not more than [~~\$1,000.~~] \$5,000."

12        SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
13 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
14 begun before its effective date.

15        SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

17        SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
