A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE FUNDING OF GRANTS PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 42F, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I. GENERAL PROVISIONS
2	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Act shall be known and may
3	be cited as the Grant Funding Act of 2019.
4	SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS. Unless otherwise clear from the
5	context, as used in this Act:
6	"Expending agency" means the executive department,
7	independent commission, bureau, office, board, or other
8	establishment of the state government (other than the
9	legislature, office of Hawaiian affairs, and judiciary), the
10	political subdivisions of the State, or any quasi-public
11	institution supported in whole or in part by state funds, which
12	is authorized to expend specified appropriations made by this
13	Act.



1 PART IV. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 2 SECTION 85. Provided that notwithstanding any law to the
- 3 contrary, funds appropriated in this Act may be transferred with
- 4 the approval of the governor to the General Appropriations Act
- 5 of 2019 (House Bill No. 2, H.D. 1, S.D. 1, C.D.1), for program
- 6 execution and expenditure.
- 7 SECTION 86. Provided that notwithstanding any law to the
- 8 contrary, funds appropriated in this Act may be transferred with
- 9 the approval of the governor to the General Improvements Act of
- 10 2019 (House Bill No. 1259, S.D. 1, C.D.1), for program execution
- 11 and expenditure.

PART V. SPECIAL PROVISIONS

- 1 SECTION 87. The governor may supplement funds for any cost
- 2 element for a capital improvement project authorized under this
- 3 Act by transferring sums as may be needed from the funds
- 4 appropriated for any other cost element of the same project by
- 5 this Act or any other prior or future act that has not lapsed;
- 6 provided that the total expenditure of funds for all cost
- 7 elements shall not exceed the total appropriations for that
- 8 project; provided further that the governor shall submit a
- 9 report to the legislature of all uses of this authority for the
- 10 previous twelve month period from December 1 to November 30 no

With the approval of the governor, expending 11 agencies that use appropriations authorized in part II of this 12 Act for planning, land acquisition, design, construction, and 13 equipment for repair and alterations may delegate that 14 responsibility and transfer funds to public works - planning, 15 design, and construction (AGS221) for the implementation of the 16 repair and alterations when it is determined by the agencies **17** that it is advantageous to do so; provided that the governor 18 shall submit to the legislature a summary report of all uses of 19 this authority for the previous twelve month period from 20 December 1 to November 30 no later than thirty days prior to the 21 convening of the regular sessions of 2020 and 2021.

1 PART VI. MISCELLANEOUS AND EFFECTIVE DATE

- 2 SECTION 97. If any portion of this Act or its application
- 3 to any person, entity, or circumstance is held to be invalid for
- 4 any reason, the legislature declares that the remainder of the
- 5 Act and each and every other provision thereof shall not be
- 6 affected thereby. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
- 7 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
- 8 be expended to fulfill the objective of that appropriation to
- 9 the extent possible.
- 10 SECTION 98. If manifest clerical, typographical, or other
- 11 mechanical errors are found in this Act, the governor is hereby
