
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LOW-SPEED ELECTRIC BICYCLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§291C- Low-speed electric bicycles; operator age. No
5 person under the age of fifteen may operate a low-speed electric
6 bicycle as defined under title 15 United States Code section
7 2085."

8 SECTION 2. Section 249-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9 amended by amending the definition of "bicycle" to read as
10 follows:

11 ""Bicycle" means [~~every~~]:

12 (1) A device propelled solely by human power upon which
13 any person may ride, having two tandem wheels sixteen
14 inches in diameter or greater, and including any
15 device generally recognized as a bicycle though
16 equipped with two front or two rear wheels[~~-~~]; or



1 (2) A low-speed electric bicycle, as defined under title
2 15 United States Code section 2085."

3 SECTION 3. Section 249-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4 amended to read as follows:

5 "**§249-14 Bicycle fee.** (a) Bicycles having two tandem
6 wheels that are twenty inches or more in diameter are required
7 to be registered and shall be subject to a permanent
8 registration fee of \$15, to be paid by the owners thereof to the
9 director of finance.

10 (b) A low-speed electric bicycle, as defined under title
11 15 United States Code section 2085, shall be required to be
12 registered, and shall be subject to a permanent registration fee
13 of \$30, to be paid by the owners thereof to the director of
14 finance.

15 [~~(b)~~] (c) An owner of a bicycle having two tandem wheels
16 that are less than twenty inches in diameter is not required to
17 register that bicycle, but may do so to facilitate the return of
18 recovered stolen bicycles by payment of the registration fee.
19 The fee collected shall not be refunded or prorated. Upon
20 receipt of the fee, the director of finance shall number and
21 register each bicycle for which the fee is paid, in the owner's



1 name, and furnish the owner with a metallic tag or decal for
2 each bicycle, which shall be attached to the bicycle. The decal
3 shall be affixed to a bicycle on the upright post attached to
4 the sprocket facing in the forward direction. Upon initial
5 registration by an owner or transferee, the director of finance
6 shall require proof of ownership and require the owner to
7 furnish verification of the serial number and description
8 contained in the proof of ownership and application for
9 registration. The metallic tags or decals shall be in a form as
10 the director of finance shall from time to time prescribe. It
11 shall be the duty of the director of finance of each county to
12 purchase a sufficient number of these tags or decals.

13 [~~e~~] (d) All fees collected under this section shall be
14 deposited into the bikeway fund and shall be expended in the
15 county in which the fees are collected as provided in section
16 249-17.5."

17 SECTION 4. Section 286-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
18 amended by amending the definition of "bicycle" to read as
19 follows:

20 ""Bicycle" means [~~every~~]:



- 1 (1) A device propelled solely by human power upon which
- 2 any person may ride, having two tandem wheels sixteen
- 3 inches in diameter or greater, and including any
- 4 device generally recognized as a bicycle though
- 5 equipped with two front or two rear wheels[-]; or
- 6 (2) A low-speed electric bicycle, as defined under title
- 7 15 United States Code section 2085."

8 SECTION 5. Section 291C-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9 amended by amending the definition of "bicycle" to read as
10 follows:

11 ""Bicycle" means [~~every~~]:

- 12 (1) A vehicle propelled solely by human power upon which
- 13 any person may ride, having two tandem wheels, and
- 14 including any vehicle generally recognized as a
- 15 bicycle though equipped with two front or two rear
- 16 wheels except a toy bicycle[-]; or
- 17 (2) A low-speed electric bicycle, as defined under title
- 18 15 United States Code section 2085."

19 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

21 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.



Report Title:

Transportation; Bicycles; Low-Speed Electric Bicycles

Description:

Includes a definition for low-speed electric bicycles to the definition of bicycle. Prohibits anyone under the age of fifteen from operating a low-speed electric bicycle. Requires low-speed electric bicycles to be registered and implements a \$30 registration fee. (HB812 HD1)
