A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The Hawaii housing finance and development
- 2 corporation shall study and formulate a plan to implement a
- 3 housing program that shall be known as the affordable, locally
- 4 owned homes for all or "ALOHA homes program".
- 5 (b) For the purpose of this Act, "ALOHA homes program"
- 6 means a program that provides low-cost, high-density leasehold
- 7 homes for sale to Hawaii residents on state-owned lands within a
- 8 one-half mile radius of a public transit station.
- 9 (c) The Hawaii housing finance and development corporation
- 10 shall submit an interim report to the legislature of its
- 11 progress, findings, and recommendations, including any proposed
- 12 legislation, no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 13 the regular session of 2020.
- 14 (d) The Hawaii housing finance and development corporation
- 15 shall submit a final report to the legislature of its findings
- 16 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, no
- 17 later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular
- 18 session of 2021.
