
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PM ZIPPER LANE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of transportation shall
2 conduct a study that reevaluates the costs and feasibility of
3 constructing a zipper lane along the H-1 freeway in the
4 westbound direction for use during the afternoon hours.

5 (b) The department of transportation shall submit a report
6 of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
7 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
8 to the convening of the regular session of 2020.

9 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
