- 12 applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this Act,
- 13 as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for those
- 14 cases to which the statute applies.
- 15 SECTION 13. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of
- 16 the appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business
- 17 on June 30, 2020, shall lapse.
- 18 SECTION 14. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 19 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
- 20 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 21 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the



- 1 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 2 of this Act are severable.
- 3 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
