# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAII CRIMINAL JUSTICE DATA CENTER FEES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 846-10.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3           "(a) Except for services provided to criminal justice  
4 agencies and state or county agencies for employment purposes,  
5 the Hawaii criminal justice data center and state and county  
6 criminal justice agencies shall assess [~~the following~~] fees for  
7 services provided or to be provided, which shall be deposited  
8 into the criminal history record improvement revolving fund[+]

9           ~~(1) For each criminal history record check or criminal  
10 history record name inquiry conducted by the data  
11 center and other state and county agencies, \$20;~~

12           ~~(2) For each criminal history record name inquiry via an  
13 electronic database maintained by the data center that  
14 is accessible to users through an interactive  
15 computer based system, for which a certified printout  
16 is requested, \$10 per printout;~~



- 1       ~~(3) For processing of each application for the expungement~~
- 2           ~~of arrest records, \$25;~~
- 3       ~~(4) For certification of documents, \$10 per document;~~
- 4       ~~(5) For each duplicate expungement certificate requested,~~
- 5           ~~\$15; and~~
- 6       ~~(6) For each complete set of fingerprints taken, \$15.]~~
- 7       ; provided that the fees assessed shall be reasonable and not
- 8       constitute a barrier to justice."

9           SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 28, 2081.
