
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO ASSESS THE PROPOSED REGULATION OF PET
BOARDING FACILITIES.

1 WHEREAS, working families in the State use the services of
2 pet boarding facilities to care for their household pets; and
3

4 WHEREAS, the State does not currently regulate pet boarding
5 facilities; and
6

7 WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires
8 that "[n]ew regulatory measures being considered for enactment
9 that, if enacted, would subject unregulated professions and
10 vocations to licensing or other regulatory controls shall be
11 referred to the auditor for analysis"; and
12

13 WHEREAS, House Bill No. 1162 (2019) proposes the regulation
14 of pet boarding facilities by the Department of Agriculture;
15 now, therefore,
16

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
18 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of
19 2019, the Senate concurring, that the Auditor is requested,
20 pursuant to section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to analyze
21 the proposed regulation of pet boarding facilities in House Bill
22 No. 1162 (2019) and to:

- 24 (1) Describe the probable effects of the measure;

26 (2) Assess whether the enactment of the measure is
27 consistent with the policies set forth in section
28 26H-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes; and

30 (3) Assess potential alternative forms of regulation; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to
 2 submit a report of findings and recommendations, including any
 3 proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty
 4 days before the convening of the Regular Session of 2020; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 7 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor and the
 8 Chairperson of the Board of Agriculture.
