## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONDUCT A STUDY ON THE NEED FOR AND FEASIBILITY OF A FERRY SERVICE BETWEEN ALOHA TOWER MARKETPLACE AND SAND ISLAND STATE RECREATION AREA.

WHEREAS, there are a number of businesses on Sand Island
 that employ workers who commute daily from other areas of Oahu,
 including the East and Windward areas of Oahu; and

5 WHEREAS, Sand Island Access Road is the only roadway that 6 provides access to Sand Island, which leads to traffic 7 congestion and delays and is burdensome to the many employees 8 who commute daily to Sand Island; and

10 WHEREAS, a ferry service that provides transportation 11 between Aloha Tower Marketplace and Sand Island State Recreation 12 Area would alleviate the traffic strain on Sand Island Access 13 Road, improve the commute for employees who work on Sand Island 14 by providing an alternate transportation option, and encourage 15 more tourism activity in Sand Island State Recreation Area; and 16

WHEREAS, increased tourism activity in Sand Island State
Recreation Area may result in an increased need for upgraded
facilities, including concessions; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 21 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 22 2019, the Senate concurring, that the Department of 23 Transportation, in consultation with the Department of Land and 24 Natural Resources, City and County of Honolulu, Hawai'i Pacific 25 26 University, and interested stakeholders, is requested to conduct a study on the need for and feasibility of a ferry service 27 between Aloha Tower Marketplace and Sand Island State Recreation 28 29 Area; and

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of 1 Transportation is requested to consider the potential costs, 2 3 financing options, and parameters of the ferry service; and 4 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is requested to consider the impact the ferry 6 service would have on tourism in Sand Island State Recreation 7 Area, including whether upgraded facilities and concessions 8 would be desirable; and 9 10 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is requested to submit its findings and 12 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 13 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 14 the Regular Session of 2020; and 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 17 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of 18 Transportation, Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural 19 20 Resources, Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu, Chairperson of the Honolulu City Council, and President of Hawai'i Pacific 21 22 University. 23 24 (SCWM-COM-25 OFFERED BY:

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
