

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND HAWAII TOURISM AUTHORITY TO REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE ON THE PROCESSING OF STATE OF HAWAII PLANT AND ANIMAL DECLARATION FORMS, INCLUDING THE COSTS INVOLVED.

WHEREAS, section 150A-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires 1 all passengers upon arrival to Hawaii to complete a State of 2 Hawaii Plant and Animal Declaration Form; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii Plant and Animal Declaration 5 Form requires information on the importation of plants and 6 animals, as well as statistical information on visitors and 7 8 residents; and 9 WHEREAS, inspections of passengers' bags for possible 10 importation of plants and animals into Hawaii are conducted by 11 federal agencies, namely the United States Department of 12 Agriculture and Transportation Security Administration prior to 13 passengers' departure from the mainland and Customs and Border 14 Control, in the case of passengers departing from international 15 locations, upon arrival in Hawaii; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii Plant and Animal Declaration 18 Form and amnesty bins at the airports are the only means by 19 which the state Department of Agriculture regulates the 20 importation of plants and animals into Hawaii; and 21 22 WHEREAS, without enhanced enforcement of importation 23 restrictions, passengers could be knowingly or unknowingly 24 importing prohibited plants and animals that pose a threat to 25 Hawaii's delicate ecosystem; and 26 27 WHEREAS, information collected from the State of Hawaii 28 29 Plant and Animal Declaration Form is reportedly processed and
