
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE HOLY SEE, THE SUPREME PONTIFF, AND THE BISHOPS OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH TO EXPLORE THE WIDESPREAD ADOPTION OF VIRI PROBATI, OR THE ORDINATION TO THE PRIESTHOOD OF CERTAIN QUALIFIED MARRIED MEN.

1 WHEREAS, the Catholic Church's policy of clerical celibacy,
2 or the discipline by which only unmarried men are ordained to
3 the priesthood, was adopted about one thousand years ago during
4 the Middle Ages; and

6 WHEREAS, clerical celibacy is a policy rooted in tradition,
7 not Catholic dogma; and

8
9 WHEREAS, in recent decades, the pernicious problem of
10 sexual abuse within the Catholic Church, particularly the sexual
11 abuse of children by Catholic clergy, has become a matter of
12 worldwide public attention and concern, resulting in
13 defrockings, resignations, and criminal convictions of numerous
14 Catholic clergy members; and

16 WHEREAS, the incidence of sexual abuse by Catholic clergy
17 is overwhelming, and both Pope John Paul II in 2001 and Pope
18 Francis in 2018 acknowledged the shame of the church's
19 collective history involving sexual abuse and the mishandling of
20 related matters by church authorities; and

22 WHEREAS, all children, including those in the care of
23 clergy members, have a right to safety and freedom from
24 physical, mental, emotional, and sexual abuse; and

26 WHEREAS, the common element of the improprieties and crimes
27 perpetrated by numerous Catholic clergy members worldwide is
28 that their wrongdoings were sexual in nature; and
