## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A TERM, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT COVERING A PORTION OF STATE SUBMERGED LANDS AT KUKUIULA, KOLOA, KONA, KAUAI, FOR A SEAWALL AND STEPS, AND FOR USE, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF THE EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED THEREON.

WHEREAS, portions of a seawall and steps fronting property identified as Tax Key No.: (4) 2-6-11:019 at Kukuiula, Koloa, Kona, Kauai, are located makai of the shoreline; and

WHEREAS, Edmund Donald Gregoire and Linda Lee Gregoire acquired the property by deed dated December 24, 2014, and thereafter learned of the encroachment of the seawall and steps; and

WHEREAS, in approximately the fall of 2015, the Gregoires began to work with the Department of Land and Natural Resources to resolve the encroachment; and

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2016, under Agenda Item D-1, the Board of Land and Natural Resources approved the grant of a non-exclusive easement for a term of fifty-five years to run with the land and to inure to the benefit of the abutting property, to resolve the encroachment; and

WHEREAS, the term, non-exclusive easement covering onehundred six square feet was appraised at a fair market value of \$7,820.00; and

WHEREAS, section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires the prior approval of the Governor and prior authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution to lease state submerged lands; now, therefore, 1 2
