
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING MAUI COUNTY TO IMMEDIATELY BAN PREDATORY COSMETICS STORES
FROM DOING BUSINESS IN LAHAINA.

1 WHEREAS, numerous predatory cosmetics stores have opened on
2 Front St. in Lahaina, creating an aggressive, intimidating
3 atmosphere for visitors; and
4

5 WHEREAS, there have been numerous complaints by residents
6 and visitors claiming that they have been accosted by the
7 personnel of these predatory cosmetics stores with the use of
8 their aggressive sales techniques; and
9

10 WHEREAS, these predatory cosmetics stores also engage in
11 unscrupulous behavior in the production of their products and in
12 the aggressive application of their products to unsuspecting
13 visitors; and
14

15 WHEREAS, the County of Maui entered into a settlement
16 agreement with these cosmetics stores, but the terms of that
17 agreement are being violated by the vendors in the course of
18 business; and
19

20 WHEREAS, the community has demanded enforcement of
21 violations of the agreement, which have repeatedly occurred; and
22

23 WHEREAS, the people of Lahaina have repeatedly demanded
24 action by the government to address these predatory cosmetics
25 stores; and
26

27 WHEREAS, previous attempts by the Legislature to address
28 this issue have proven futile because the Legislature may only
29 address issues of a general nature, rather than specifically
30 targeting a certain area; and


1 WHEREAS, under the Hawaii State Constitution, the counties
 2 are given authority to regulate business uses in a particular
 3 area via their zoning powers; and
 4

5 WHEREAS, the counties, through zoning ordinances and the
 6 zoning process, have prohibited certain types of businesses from
 7 operating in certain areas because of the businesses' general
 8 negative effect on the health, safety, and welfare of the
 9 citizens of the communities, such as places of adult
 10 entertainment activity; and
 11

12 WHEREAS, by prohibiting predatory cosmetics stores through
 13 the zoning process, landlords would be incentivized to
 14 diligently address the actions of their cosmetics store tenants;
 15 now, therefore,
 16

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
 18 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of
 19 2019, the Senate concurring, that Maui County is urged to
 20 immediately ban predatory cosmetics stores in Lahaina; and
 21

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 23 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of Maui
 24 County, Chair of the Maui County Council, West Maui
 25 representative of the Maui County Council, Director of the
 26 Planning Department of Maui County, President of the Lahaina
 27 Town Action Committee, and President of the West Maui Taxpayers
 28 Association.
