
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE FORMATION OF A TASK FORCE ON NORTH ROAD
MANAGEMENT.

1 WHEREAS, North Road in Ewa Beach is a long, straight
2 thoroughfare that connects the community to its schools, parks,
3 churches, and other areas of Ewa Beach; and
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5 WHEREAS, safety, illegal dumping, and maintenance continue
6 to be serious concerns on Ewa Beach's North Road; and
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8 WHEREAS, these issues are complicated by the ownership by
9 three entities over various portions of the road, one entity
10 being private and the other two public; now, therefore,
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12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
13 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of
14 2019, the Senate concurring, that representatives from the
15 Department of Transportation, City and County of Honolulu, Ewa
16 Beach Golf Course, Carmel Partners, Iroquois Point, and Ewa
17 Beach Neighborhood Board are requested to form a task force on
18 North Road management; and
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20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of
21 Transportation is requested to organize four task force
22 meetings; and
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24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is requested to
25 report its recommendations on safety improvements and unified
26 management of North Road to the Legislature no later than eight
27 months after the adoption of this measure; and



1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
2 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of
3 Transportation, Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu, Clerk
4 of the City and County of Honolulu, Manager of the Ewa Beach
5 Golf Course, Manager of Carmel Partners, Manager of Iroquois
6 Point, and Chairperson of the Ewa Beach Neighborhood Board.
