HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII STATE ENERGY OFFICE TO PERFORM A STUDY ON THE FEASIBILITY OF INCENTIVIZING THE CREATION OF A GLASS AND SOLAR PANEL RECYCLING PLANT USING FUNDS FROM A FEE TO BE ATTACHED TO EACH SOLAR PANEL SOLD IN THE STATE.

WHEREAS, the State has incentivized the purchase of solar 1 panels by expanding the renewable energy technologies income tax 2 credit under section 235-12.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, in 2009 3 to include a refundable tax credit for solar energy systems; and 4 5 WHEREAS, sales of solar panels for both heating water and 6 generating electricity have significantly increased since the 7 implementation of the refundable income tax credit; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, the State now leads the nation in the number of solar panels used per capita; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, although new solar panels degrade at a slower rate than older solar panel models, new solar panels still degrade at 14 15 a rate of five percent per year; and 16 WHEREAS, because there are currently no glass or solar 17 panel recycling plants in the State, glass must be shipped out 18 of the State for recycling; and 19 20 21 WHEREAS, due to the pervasiveness of solar panels throughout the State and the general rate of degradation of 22 solar panels, demand for replacement solar panels will soon 23 increase; now, therefore, 24 25 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 26 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 27 2019, that the Hawaii State Energy Office is requested to 28 29 perform a study on the feasibility of incentivizing the creation of a glass and solar panel recycling plant using funds from a 30 fee to be attached to each solar panel sold in the State; and 31
